

Stretch the cheese: stretch / stretch


Mix the salsa: stir/stir (4x)
Fill your tortilla with salsa, cheese, and lettuce (3x)





Black Marker

Crayons

String or dental floss

Instructions

Meatball Umbrella Activity



Start with cutting the umbrella shape from the paper plate, after with black marker add black lines for the fold of the umbrella to add dimension. From here have the children decorate their umbrella as they see fit.



Next cut out a handle for the umbrella from black construction paper and affiz it to your umbrella top. Next cut your clear string or dental floss. Also cut out around 3 large brown paper meatballs


